<b>Class 1</b>	<b>HARNESS HORSE EXCEEDING 14.2hh – SHOWN IN HAND</b> This class will be split at the Judge's discretion.
<b>Class 2</b>	<b>HARNESS PONY EXCEEDING 12.2hh NOT EXCEEDING 14.2hh – SHOWN IN HAND</b>
<b>Class 3</b>	<b>HARNESS PONY NOT EXCEEDING 12.2hh – SHOWN IN HAND</b>
<b>Class 4</b>	<b>VETERAN HARNESS HORSE OR PONY SHOWN IN HAND</b> 16 years or over. Proof of age may be required.
<b>**** IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP ****</b> <b>Open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize Winners in Classes 1,2, 3 and 4</b>	
<b>Class 5</b>	<b>YOUNGSTOCK CLASS – YOUNGSTOCK UP TO AND INCLUDING 3 YEAR OLDS AND FOALS</b> (Foals born in 2010 can be shown with or without mares)
<b>Class 6</b>	<b>PAIRS – LONG REINING</b> Pairs to be long reined accompanied by a groom. To be judged solely on suitability as a driving pair. Horses/Ponies to be joined via the reins only and should not have a strap attached to the pads.
<b>Class 7</b>	<b>OVER 13.2hh SINGLE LONG-REINING.</b> To be accompanied by a groom.
<b>Class 8</b>	<b>13.2hh &amp; UNDER SINGLE LONG-REINING.</b> To be accompanied by a groom.

<b>Class 9</b>	<b>DRIVING CLASS FOR SINGLE HORSE OR PONY WHO HAS NOT WON MORE THAN FOUR FIRSTS IN A NOVICE CLASS AT ANY J.H.D.S SHOW.</b> Once a Horse or Pony has competed in a Private Driving Class either locally or UK or Europe it cannot compete in the Novice Class with the exception of Osborne Refrigerator Qualifiers from 1999 onwards as the only competitor. (Bonafide exercise vehicles only).
<b>Class 10</b>	<b>NOVICE WHIP</b> open to Novices who have not won this class more than four times. If there is only one entrant in the class the competitor will still be regarded as eligible for the Novice Whip class in the future. (Bonafide exercise vehicles only).
<b>Class 11</b>	<b>YOUNG DRIVER WHIP.</b> Open to Junior Members only. Turnouts can be shared between more than one Young Driver. (Bonafide exercise vehicles only).
<b>Class 12</b>	<b>BEST NON HACKNEY HORSE EXCEEDING 14.2hh ON THE MOVE.</b> (Bonafide exercise vehicles only).
<b>Class 13</b>	<b>BEST NON HACKNEY PONY EXCEEDING 12.2hh &amp; NOT EXCEEDING 14.2hh ON THE MOVE.</b> (Bonafide exercise vehicles only).
<b>Class 14</b>	<b>BEST NON HACKNEY PONY NOT EXCEEDING 12.2hh ON THE MOVE.</b> (Bonafide exercise vehicles only).
<b>Class 15</b>	<b>BEST HACKNEY or HACKNEY TYPE HORSE OR PONY ON THE MOVE.</b> (Bonafide exercise vehicles only).
<b>****ON THE MOVE CHAMPIONSHIP****</b> <b>Open to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize Winners of Classes 12 to 15</b>

<b>Class 16</b>	<b>PRIVATE DRIVING FOR SINGLE PONIES NOT EXCEEDING 12.2hh.</b> To be driven to a traditional vehicle (excluding vans or trade type)
<b>Class 17</b>	<b>PRIVATE DRIVING FOR SINGLE PONIES EXCEEDING 12.2hh and not exceeding 14.2hh.</b> To be driven to a traditional vehicle (excluding vans or trade type)
<b>Class 18</b>	<b>PRIVATE DRIVING FOR SINGLE HORSES EXCEEDING 14.2hh.</b> To be driven to a traditional vehicle (excluding vans or trade type)
<b>Class 19</b>	<b>COUNTRY CLASS FOR SINGLE OR MULTIPLES- HORSE(S) OR PONY(S) IN COUNTRY VEHICLES</b> This class includes vans but excludes gigs, exercise vehicles and Hackney Show Wagons. NOTE: The two highest placed singles and the two highest placed multiples within the first 5 places will qualify for the Pony/Horse Championship and the Supreme Championship respectively.
<b>Class 20</b>	<b>BEST TURNED OUT HORSE/PONY SHOWN IN AN OPEN VAN OR LIGHT TRADE.</b> To be judged 30% Horse, 30% Vehicle, 25% Harness & 15% Personal Appearance. There will be a prize for the Best Brass.
<b>Class 21</b>	<b>OPEN PAIRS – ANY HEIGHT.</b> To be driven to either a traditional or exercise vehicle
	**** PONY CHAMPIONSHIP**** Open to 1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> Prize Winners in Classes 16, 17 and if applicable 19, 20
	****HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP **** Open to 1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> Prize Winners in Classes 18 and if applicable 19, 20
