NOTES ON THE 2010 ANNUAL MEMBERS SHOW

**At J.H.D.S. Showground, Main Road, St Lawrence on Saturday 7th and
Sunday 8th August 2010 commencing at 9.00am on both days**

- All entries to be made **BY POST** to Mrs Fleur White, Fairlight, Les Gellettes, St Lawrence, Jersey, JE3 1EN by 5th July, 2010. Any entries received postmarked after 5th July, 2010 will be classed as late entries. No entries will be taken over the telephone and no late entries will be accepted until the day of the show. - All trophies to be returned to Mrs Fleur White, Fairlight, Les Gellettes, St St Laurent, St Lawrence, Jersey, JE3 1EN by 5th July, 2010. **Please ensure that trophies are cleaned immediately prior to return. Please note a fine of £5.00 will be levied if not cleaned at time of return or returned after 5th July, 2010. Entries will not be accepted if a trophy has not been returned.**
- Dogs are allowed on the show field but must be on a lead at all times and owners must clean up their dog mess.
- For all classes horses/ponies must be owned by a JHDS member and must be bona fide driving horses/ponies.
- For all classes except Class 5 Horses/ponies must be four years old or over to be eligible to compete.
- All horses/ponies entered in the Young stock Class & Veteran classes must have their exact age (on the day of the show) inserted on the entry form.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel or combine any class.
- The Show Committee or Jersey Horse Driving Society accepts no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to persons, animals or vehicles resulting from the Show.
- Any competitor/spectator arguing and making a public nuisance of themselves will be issued with a warning by the Show Committee. If the offender persists in their behaviour they will be asked to leave the showground immediately and all entry money will be forfeited if applicable.
- Any objections to be lodged on the day of the Show in writing addressed to the Show Chairman and his Committee.
- If a driver is to be changed, the Show Secretary must be notified prior to the proceeding class otherwise they will not be allowed in the ring.
- If a horse or pony is substituted then this will be classed as a late entry.
- Young Drivers must be accompanied at all times by a competent adult driver.
- Whips must be carried at all times.
- When changing rein competitors must pass left shoulder to left shoulder, thus enabling competitors going in the opposite direction to pass on the outside.
- There is to be no overtaking on the inside when in the ring. If you are too close to the horse/pony in front then you must turn a circle.
- Competitors must ensure that their areas in the car park are left clean and tidy.
- Entries will be refunded upon presentation of a vet's certificate.
- Pneumatic tyred vehicles will not be permitted in Classes 16,17,18,19, 20 & 22.
- All competitors **MUST** abide by the instructions given to them by the ring steward.
- **Insurance** a copy of your current insurance certificate must have been verified by the JHDS before any entry can be accepted. (please give to Catherine Peters)
- **Entry Fees**
£5.00 per class. Late entries £10.00 per class.
Late entries will only be accepted up until the start of the previous class.
