## **NOTES ON THE 2010 MIDSUMMER SHOW**

**Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> June 2010 commencing at 9.00am at  
J.H.D.S. Showground, Main Road, St Lawrence**

- All entries to be made **BY POST** to Mrs Fleur White, Fairlight, Les Gellettes, St Lawrence, Jersey, JE3 1EN by 3<sup>rd</sup> May, 2010. Any entries received postmarked after 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2010. will be classed as late entries. No entries will be taken over the telephone and no late entries will be accepted until the day of the show. Enquiries telephone Fleur White on 861338
- All trophies to be returned to Mrs Fleur White, Fairlight, Les Gellettes, St Lawrence, Jersey, JE3 1EN by 3<sup>rd</sup> May, 2010. **Please ensure that trophies are cleaned immediately prior to return.** Please note a fine of £5.00 will be levied if not cleaned at time of return or returned after 3<sup>rd</sup> May, 2010.. Entries will not be accepted if a trophy has not been returned.
- Dogs are allowed on the show field but must be on a lead at all times and owners must clean up their dog mess.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel or combine any class.
- The Show Committee or Jersey Horse Driving Society accepts no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to persons, animals or vehicles resulting from the Show.
- Any competitor/spectator arguing and making a public nuisance of themselves will be issued with a warning by the Show Committee. If the offender persists in their behaviour they will be asked to leave the showground immediately and all entry money will be forfeited if applicable.
- Any objections to be lodged on the day of the Show to the Show Chairman and his Committee.
- If a driver is to be changed, the Show Secretary must be notified prior to the proceeding class otherwise they will not be allowed in the ring.
- If a horse or pony is substituted then this will be classed as a late entry.
- Young Drivers must be accompanied at all times by a competent adult driver.
- Whips must be carried at all times.
- When changing rein competitors must pass left shoulder to left shoulder, thus enabling competitors going in the opposite direction to pass on the outside.
- There is to be no overtaking when in the ring. If you are too close to the horse/pony in front then you must turn a circle.
- Competitors must ensure that their areas in the car park are left clean and tidy.
- Entries will be refunded upon presentation of a vet's certificate.
- Pneumatic tyred vehicles will not be permitted in Classes 5 – 8 inc.
- Please note that for the Concours D'Elegance Classes only, there will be a split at not exceeding 13.2 hh for ponies and exceeding 13.2 hh for horses and ponies.
- All competitors MUST abide by the instructions given to them by the ring steward.
- **Membership qualification** – all competitors/grooms must be a fully paid up JHDS member. Any day members (approved by a quorum of the General Committee only) must also show proof of third party liability and horse category insurance cover if applicable.
- Your insurance must cover any additional passengers
- Horses/ponies must be four years old or over to be eligible to compete
- For **Classes 15 & 16** no cantering allowed other than in your own individual show.
- **Entry Fees**  
**£5.00 per class. Late entries £8.00 per class.**  
Late entries on an official entry form will only be accepted up until the start of the previous class.
- **Insurance** a copy of your current insurance certificate must have been verified by the JHDS before any entry can be accepted. ( please give to Catherine.Peters)
