The Junior /novice show was blessed with glorious weather, there were a wide range of classes to suit the less experienced, this show has become a useful stepping stone to the major shows.

Mrs Nicola Salter from Nottinghamshire was very impressed with the horses and ponies and also the junior drivers were well up to standard of the UK.

The morning programme was devoted to in hand and long reining classes for horses and ponies and also leaders ability to produce the best from their charges, with some classes having thirteen entries the judge had much to deliberate. In Hand class for juniors, ten year old Ellie Carre was first followed by Kieran O' Conner and Kim Gallichan.

The novice driver in hand was a first for Phillipa Knight who handled Bobby with confidence from Dave Gallichan with Rosemary Ahier's piebald Robert who went better and better as the day progressed much to his owner's delight, third was Kerrie Le Crom with Tara Hill's Shetland pony Dryfesdale Ducati.

The largest class of the day was the Novice Horse or Pony, the judge decided to split the class into small and large, the small division was another win for Phillipa with Bobby, second was Tara Hill with her Shetland stallion Halawi Acer. Chillipepper, the lovely Irish Sport Horse owned by Brooke Allan headed the large section at his first outing followed by another newcomer Emma Eden's Scrumpy a coloured French cob.

Onto the long reining classes, junior Kieran O'Conner with Ovington Hermes did a lovely show to be placed ahead of Kim and Ellie.

Kerrie Le Crom with the diminutive Halawi Acer won the Novice Driver class, compared to the large horses Kerry normally rides she stated it was like "walking the dog"!

The Novice horse or pony long reining was also split; Catherine Peters was delighted to win with Brynthon Legacy a youngster she has been bringing on; second was another on its first outing the chestnut mare Glyncoch Anna shown by Julie Chalker and owned by Deen Bownes. Kelly Moulin with Toby, one of Posy Biles many entries were first to Vincent Obbard's Max in the large division.

The afternoon was devoted to the driving classes, starting with the Junior Whip, Kieran O'Conner's recent practicing paid off and put in a polished performance, Ellie and Kim also drove very well which impressed the judge.

Two competitors in the Novice whip saw a win for a delighted Jean Michel a long time stalwart of the club with the Viberts Burnhead Jester, second was Dave Gallichan who drove Rose Ahier's Robert sympathetically and consequently continued to gain in confidence.

David with Robert came to the fore again in the Novice horse or pony class which is judged like a private driving class whereby horse/carriage/ harness is taken into consideration, second was Vincent Obbard with Tara and her plucky little stallion in third.

A good course was set up for the handy classes to demonstrate obedience, from negotiating a chicane to posting a letter amongst other things. Winner of the junior class was Kieran whilst Ellie and Kim were equal second. In the novice horse or pony class Vincent was particularly pleased with his round with Max to take the red ribbon, Dave came second, Charlie Ahier took the reins with Robert to win the novice handy driver class, with Jean Michel a creditable second.

The numerous points were totted up; sponsored by Emma Le Marquand the winner of the Junior Points trophy was Kieran O'Conner, The novice driver Trophy sponsored by Lisa Fenlon went to David Gallichan and the Trophy for Novice Horse or Pony sponsored by Bev and Ian Le Marquand was won by Vincent Obbard.
