Class 1	PAIRS and TANDEMS (MULTIPLES) – Any height. To be driven to an exercise vehicle Osborne Qualifier (n)
Class 2	DRIVING CLASS FOR SINGLE HORSE OR PONY WHO HAS NOT WON MORE THAN FOUR FIRSTS IN A NOVICE CLASS AT ANY J.H.D.S SHOW Once a Horse or Pony has competed in a Private Driving Class either locally or UK or Europe it cannot compete in the Novice Class with the exception of Osborne Refrigerator Qualifiers from 1999 onwards as the only competitor. (Bonafide exercise vehicles only).
Class 3	NOVICE WHIP Open to Novices who have not won this class more than four times or won a 1 st in any other Whip Class. If there is only one entrant in the Novice Whip Class the competitor will still be regarded as eligible for the Novice Whip Class in the future. Exercise vehicles are permitted.
Class 4	SINGLE TURNOUT DRIVEN TO A TWO OR FOUR WHEELED EXERCISE VEHICLE (Osborne Qualifier : l and m)
Class 5	PRIVATE DRIVING FOR SINGLE HORSES/PONIES EXCEEDING 13.2hh To be driven to a traditional vehicle (excluding vans or trade type) (Osborne Qualifier :a, b and e)
Class 6	PRIVATE DRIVING FOR SINGLE PONIES NOT EXCEEDING 13.2hh To be driven to a traditional vehicle (excluding vans or trade type) (Osborne Qualifier : c, f and g)
Class 7	BEST TURNED OUT HORSE/PONY DRIVEN TO AN OPEN VAN OR LIGHT TRADE VEHICLE. To be judged 30% Horse, 30% Vehicle, 25% Harness & 15% Personal Appearance. There will be a Trophy and Rosette for the Best Brass.
Class 8	COUNTRY CLASS FOR SINGLE HORSE OR PONY IN COUNTRY VEHICLES This class includes vans but excludes gigs, exercise vehicles and Hackney Show Wagons. (Osborne Qualifier : d)
Class 9	PAIRS AND TANDEMS (MULTIPLES) – Any height. To be driven to a traditional vehicle (Osborne Qualifier : (i)

Class 10	PRIVATE DRIVING FOR YOUNG DRIVER (JUNIOR) Turnouts can be shared between more than one Young Driver aged between 10 and 17 – see below re Osborne qualifiers. Traditional or Exercise vehicles are permitted. (Osborne Qualifier :o,p, r)
	CONCOURS TO BE JUDGED ON THE MOVE – No close inspection or show
Class 11	CONCOURS D’ELEGANCE FOR PONIES NOT EXCEEDING 13.2hh

Class 12	CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE FOR HORSES/PONIES EXCEEDING 13.2hh
	Classes 13 to 16 – On the Move will be judged solely ON THE MOVE. There is No Stand Show. Enter the ring at WALK, then COLLECTED TROT . EACH competitor will complete an individual walk, trot and extended trot.
Class 13	BEST NON HACKNEY PONY NOT EXCEEDING 12.2hh ON THE MOVE
Class 14	BEST NON HACKNEY PONY EXCEEDING 12.2hh & NOT EXCEEDING 14.2hh ON THE MOVE
Class 15	BEST NON HACKNEY HORSE EXCEEDING 14.2hh ON THE MOVE
Class 16	BEST HACKNEY TYPE HARNESS HORSE OR PONY ON THE MOVE.

OSBORNE REFRIGERATORS BDS NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS 2010

Classes 1, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10 inc. include a qualifier for the 2010 Osborne Refrigerators BDS National Championships. The highest placed turnout owned and driven by a Member of the British Driving Society and eligible for the following Type-Section(s) disregarding those already qualified down to 6th place in the class will qualify for the 2010 Osborne Refrigerators Semi-final. A Judge has the right to withhold qualification if she/he deems it appropriate.

Type sections are as follows:

- a) Single hackney- type
- b) Single Non-Hackney Type (excluding purebred Registered Welsh) over 13.2 hh
- c) Single Non-Hackney Type (excluding purebred Registered Welsh) 13.2hh & under
- d) Single Country Turnout
- e) Single purebred Registered Welsh Cobs Section D
- f) Single purebred Registered Welsh Ponies Section C
- g) Single purebred Registered Welsh Ponies Sections A&B
- i) Pairs and Tandems – Open. Any height
- l) Single Turnout driven to a two wheeled exercise vehicle.
- m) Single Turnout driven to a four wheeled exercise vehicle.
- n) Pair or tandem put to an exercise vehicle
- o) Single turnout driven to a traditional type vehicle by a young driver aged 10 – 14 years
- p) Single turnout driven to a traditional type vehicle by a young driver aged 15 – 17 years
- r) Single turnout driven to an exercise type vehicle by a young driver aged 15-17 years
